EU – China Partnering Initiative on fibre crops – Mandatory China : There is a renewed interest in fibre crops as a sustainable source of biobased material Funding Scheme: Coordination and Support Action (coordinating action).

Additional information: Up to one project may be funded. It is expected that CAAS will fund Chinese partners of the project with comparable funding.

Jean-François Renault (NKS „Umwelt“) Auswertung Beteiligung China in FP7 Bereich nachhaltiges Landnutzungsmanagement:



- „Chinesische Einrichtungen haben sich unabhängig davon, ob die Topics von der Kommission explizit für eine Kooperation mit China ausgeschrieben wurden oder nicht, erfolgreich beworben. Damit wurde die wissenschaftliche Exzellenz der beteiligten chinesischen Einrichtungen klar bestätigt.“
- „Bisher fehlen folgende wichtige Thematiken der nationalen bzw. der deutsch-chinesischen Zusammenarbeit gänzlich: integriertes Ressourcenmanagement inkl. Nutzung der Biomasse, Stadt-Land-Beziehungen, Governance models, Lösungen für Nutzungskonflikte, Flächenmanagement“
- „Eine gemeinsame Antragstellung bei zukünftigen ausgeschrieben Topics zur Landnutzung (soweit vorhanden!) mit ausgesuchten chinesischen Einrichtungen wird empfohlen. Dabei sollte die Koordinierung durch deutsche Einrichtungen angestrebt werden.“
